Alzheimer's is life changing for the person with the disease, as well as their family and friends, but information and support are available. No one has to face Alzheimer's disease or another dementia alone.

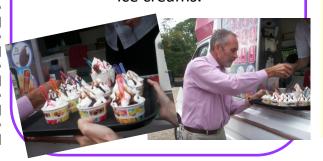
It was certainly a thought provoking day, and a time for reflection. Here at Norwood House we understand that each of our residents is unique in how they are affected by this disease.
