We believe that dance and movement can help improve our residents memory and cognitive functioning; as well as creating a sense of mindfulness. This non-verbal communication has become increasingly important as many dementias affect language, but through singing, dance and movement we are ALL interacting together.

The ladies of Norwood House like to regularly visit our Hairdresser, Kay, who thoroughly enjoys giving them some extra special styles.



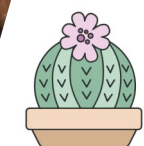


Let's Paint Together....

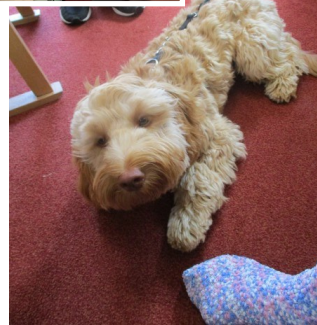
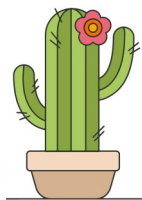

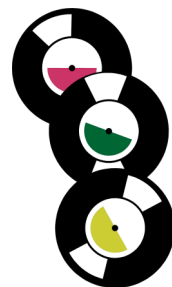


THE 60s

Amelia and Mary were delighted to be in on the closing act of the recent 'Tickled Pink' production.



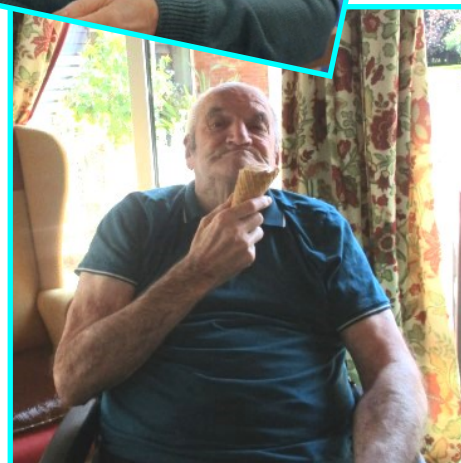
